9. Discussion and possible action on Eagle Elementary School of the Arts grant application.
10. Discussion and possible action concerning the “Beautify Downtown Eagle” project sign located on the southeast corner of the Eagle Road/State Street intersection. Possible courses of action could include, without limitation, updating the sign, removing the sign or making no changes to the sign.
11. Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code 67-2345(1)(c) and (f) – To consider acquisition of an interest in real property and to communicate with legal counsel regarding pending litigation, or controversies not yet being litigated but imminently likely to be litigated. **NO PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN ON THIS ITEM.**

Consideration of a subproject plan (prepared by South Landscape Architecture) for submission to, and review and approval by, the City of Eagle (aka the downtown public parking lot and blight elimination subproject generally located on the southwest corner of the Eagle Road/State Street intersection). The uses contemplated in the subproject by the URA are already addressed in the Eagle Urban Renewal Plan for the Downtown and East End Urban Renewal Project so such a submission is optional and not required.
13. Finalize the aggregate amount, not-to-exceed interest rate, number of years to maturity and other terms for the bonds to be issued for funds for the downtown public parking lot. The possible not-to-exceed amount is about \$950,000, but the agency may consider an amount closer to \$500,000.
