Eagle Urban Renewal Agency Release a Request for Proposal for 51 and 67 East State Street

EAGLE, ID – On April 05, 2022, the Eagle Urban Renewal Agency Board of Commissioners (EURA) voted to approve the April 11th release of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for the two agency-owned properties located at 51 and 67 East State Street.

The EURA is soliciting proposals from developers, development teams, or individual developers in presenting a viable proposal, design, and concept for the purchase and redevelopment of the two properties known as the former Eagle Museum of History and the current barbershop. The EURA is looking for creative redevelopment proposal that will enhance the character and the economic vitality of downtown Eagle.

Proposals will be due to Ashley Squyres, the Executive Director of the EURA, by 4:00 pm on Friday, July 08, 2022. It is anticipated that the RFP Committee will review and interview respondents in August, and will make a recommendation to the EURA board in September.

The EURA was created in 2006 with the mission to facilitate, promote, renovate, reinvigorate, and stimulate growth in Eagle by being a resource to the community.
