BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE EAGLE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF EAGLE, IDAHO, A/K/A EURA:

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF EAGLE, IDAHO, APPROVING THE USE OF THE 2022 ADA COUNTY MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN AS A GENERAL GUIDE TO SUCH PLANNING AND MITIGATION EFFORTS BY THE EURA; AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION REQUIRED TO IMPLEMENT THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

THIS RESOLUTION, made on the date hereinafter set forth by the Eagle Urban Renewal Agency of the City of Eagle, Idaho, an independent public body corporate and politic, authorized under the authority of the Idaho Urban Renewal Law of 1965, as amended, Chapter 20, Title 50, Idaho Code, a duly created and functioning urban renewal agency of the City of Eagle, Idaho, hereinafter referred to as the "EURA."

WHEREAS, the EURA, an independent public body, corporate and politic, is an urban renewal agency created by and existing under the authority of and pursuant to the 'Idaho Urban Renewal Law of 1965, being Idaho Code title 50, chapter 20, as amended and supplemented, and the Local Economic Development Act of 1988, being Idaho Code, Title 50, Chapter 29; as amended and supplemented (collectively the "Act");

WHEREAS, the EURA was established by Resolution No. 06-50 of the City Council of the City of Eagle, Idaho (hereinafter the "City Council"), adopted October 10, 2006:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Eagle, Idaho (the "City"), on December 11, 2007, after notice duly published, conducted a public hearing on the Eagle Revitalization Plan (the "Revitalization Plan");

WHEREAS, following said public hearing the City adopted its Ordinance No. 592 on December 11, 2007, approving the Revitalization Plan and making certain findings;

WHEREAS, all of Ada County has exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment, and the County's economy;

WHEREAS, pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property;

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre- and post-disaster hazard mitigation programs;

WHEREAS, a coalition of Ada County stakeholders with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies to be implemented within each partners identified capabilities, within the Ada County Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating, and revising this strategy.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY OF EAGLE, IDAHO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The EURA approves in its entirety, Volume I and the appendices of Volume II of the 2022 Ada County Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan for use as a guide by the EURA in any of its related planning efforts.

<u>Section 2</u>. The EURA will use the approved portions of the Hazard Mitigation Plan as a general guide if it engages in any pre- and post- disaster mitigation efforts of the hazards identified.

<u>Section 3</u>. Where the EURA has proper authority and if it engages in any mitigation activities or planning efforts it will coordinate the strategies identified in the Hazard Mitigation Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.

<u>Section 4</u>. The EURA will continue its support of the on-going countywide mitigation efforts as deemed necessary and appropriate by the EURA Board to participate in the Planning Partnership as described by the Hazard Mitigation Plan.

<u>Section 5</u>. As deemed appropriate by the EURA Board the EURA will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all Planning Partners.
